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## SPIDERS ARE MAN'S FRIENDS

Why are spiders our best friends ? Simply because they destroy many harmful insects, including some of our worst enemies. These are the insects that devour our crops, cause diseases both to us and to farm animals, and torment our skins. Spiders do not have specific insects which they prey on. They kill and eat whatever insects are available, though they do not usually prey on the large ones.

There are two main groups of spiders: the weaving spiders and the hunting spiders. These two groups differ in various ways. The weavers have bigger spinnerets (those parts of the body from which the silk comes out) and their legs are generally much anger, with special

claws at the end. The hunting spiders (which do not spin webs) have better eyesight than the weavers, but the weavers' sense of touch is more developed, and they are more highly evolved than the hunters. The weavers do not take the trouble to hunt their prey, instead they set a trap and wait for the prey to get caught in it. This trap is of course, the web, which is made from the spider's silk. This is very important for the spider, since the stickiness helps to prevent his prey from escaping. The spider itself, however, can run across the web because it has a kind of oil on its feet, which therefore do not stick to the web.
