Indira Gandhi became 'Minor minister' in Lal Bahadur Shastri's Government. After Shastri's death she was elected as first prime minister of India. Her time in the office was never peaceful. Indira Gandhi had earned at one time or another both the love and enmity of her people.

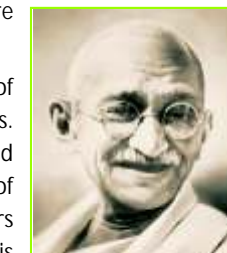
